ASSISTED PASSENGERS ARRIVING 1848-1854

ARRIVALS AT MORETON BAY, PORT PHILLIP, SYDNEY & TWOFOLD BAY

I am pleased to announce the publication of this exciting project containing 23,262 transcriptions including an index of the records of the employment and dispersal lists of assisted passengers arriving at Moreton Bay, Port Phillip, Sydney and one to Twofold Bay for the period 1848 to 1854.

- These lists have been extracted from the NSW Governor's Despatches with the exception of the general and disposal list of the female immigrants on the **Culloden* which is from the NSW Colonial Secretary's In-Letters. The immigrant details include name, age and occupation and there are also births and deaths with dates for each and, for deaths, the cause is given in most cases.
- Whenever found, many additional reports have been included for these lists, also any found for those where the lists are missing, and they are sourced not only from the Despatches but also from the NSW Colonial Secretary's correspondence. These PDF files are accessible via the Help button. For each of the surviving lists, there are at least two transcriptions and often more and, whenever found, also reports for those missing lists.
- The names on these lists have been compared with those on the shipping lists and variants of surnames, forenames and in many instances ages have been included in the Remarks. While checking those records, often other individual details from the shipping lists have also been noted.
- The fields are: Surname, ForeName; Age; Occ[upation]; Ship; St[atus]; Dep[arture] Port; Arr[ival] Port; Ref[erence]; Remarks; NSW GD; Ship Report; Addl Docs [Additional Documents].
- Fully searchable by most fields including **Surname* and *ForeName* **Ship* **Arrival Port* **Reference* **Remarks* and many others; or a combination of any of these; and also by **Record Number* OR **Full Search* which searches many fields in one search.
- Search results can be **Sorted* and **Printed* or **Exported* in several formats such as MS Excel spreadsheet, MS Word, HTML, PDF, RTF, TIFF, XFF and Open Office Writer – PDF files are recommended to retain format.
- Compatible with Windows XP to Windows 8.
